

DIY SIMPLE FABRIC BASKET

Front Fabric - 14" x 20"
Lining Fabric - 14" x 20"
Interfacing - 13" x 19" (two pieces)

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1. Choose two Fat Quarters that coordinate and press the fabric. You can also use yardage.
2. Cut fabric to measure 14" x 20". Cut two pieces of Interfacing to measure 13" x 19"
3. Press the Interfacing to the Lining Fabric.
4. If you're adding a label, pin it in the seam line on the front of the outside (front) fabric.
5. Fold your fabric in half, pin or clip and sew down the left and right side. Sew with a 1/4" seam. Do this step on both the front fabric and lining fabric.
6. Using a Grid and an erasable marker, trace a 2" square on bottom corners. Cut out, pinch together, clip and sew (1/4" seam).
7. Turn the lining fabric right side out and place it inside the front fabric (right sides of fabric should be facing each other). Clip or pin around the basket.
8. Sew together with a **1/2" seam** and leave a 2" opening. Turn right sides out and sew it closed with a 1/4" seam.
